



Online Workshop on Preparing Schools for Transformative School Based Assessment (SBA) of Learning vis-à-vis NEP-2020

(Holistic Progress Card & Competency Based Assessment-SAFAL & NIPUN)

National Education Policy (NEP)-2020 has envisioned transformation changes in prevailing School Based Assessment (SBA) system for Learning outcomes & learning progress. Adhering to provisions stipulated in NEP-2020, School Education Department, Affiliating and regulatory bodies at Centre & State level have initiated several schemes for smooth transitions to transformational assessment practices in sync with recommendations of NEP-2020. This online workshop has been designed for enabling participants: -

- ❖ To understand what would be assessed and how several types of assessments would be conducted
- ❖ To understand transformational changes recommended in NEP-2020 for School Based Assessment (SBA)
- To understand assessment tools & techniques required for implementing "Holistic Progress Card" as part of School Based Assessment (SBA)
- To understand comparatively transformational changes envisaged in NEP-2020 regarding micro level (School or grass root level) & macro level (District/State/National) level assessment of learning outcomes
- ❖ To understand requirements for switching towards Competency Based Assessment (CBA)
- ❖ To understand Assessment through Portfolios & Rubrics
- To decode Competency Based Assessment (CBA) in the light of NIPUN (National Initiatives for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy) (Note: NIPUN is implementation guidelines National Mission on Foundational Literacy & Numeracy launched by Department of School Education and Literacy and all schools will have to adhere to NIPUN)
- To decode Competency Based Assessment (CBA) in the light of SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analysing Learning) (Note: SAFAL is launched by CBSE for its affiliated schools and all schools will have to undergo for competency based assessment of students studying grades 3rd, 5th and 8th)
