- To understand the **importance of periodic data driven reviews** and performance review meetings.
- To be **enabled to take up Action Research projects** which will help the school operate with increased **effectiveness, consistency & efficiency**.
- Shifts the school's approach of problem solving from a **corrective mode to preventive mode**.
- Enables the schools **take decision based on data analysis** and not on assumptions/ experience alone.
- Action Research is a method of **systematic enquiry** that the teachers/ school administrators, etc. undertake as researchers of their own practices.
- Helps in systematizing processes/ changes for **continual improvement**.
- It will also enable schools to take up **Action Research Projects** which will help the school operate with increased effectiveness, consistency & efficiency.
